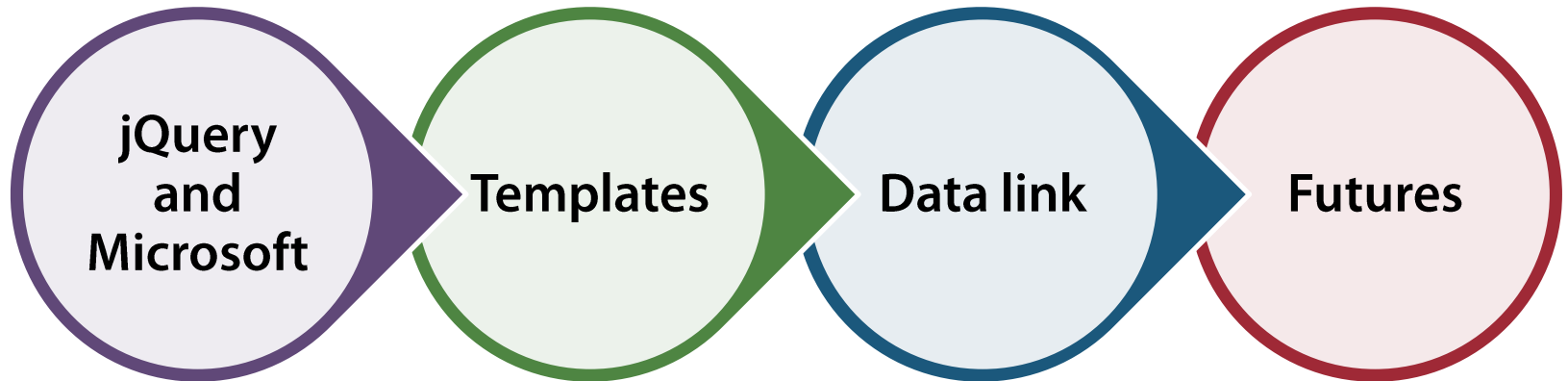

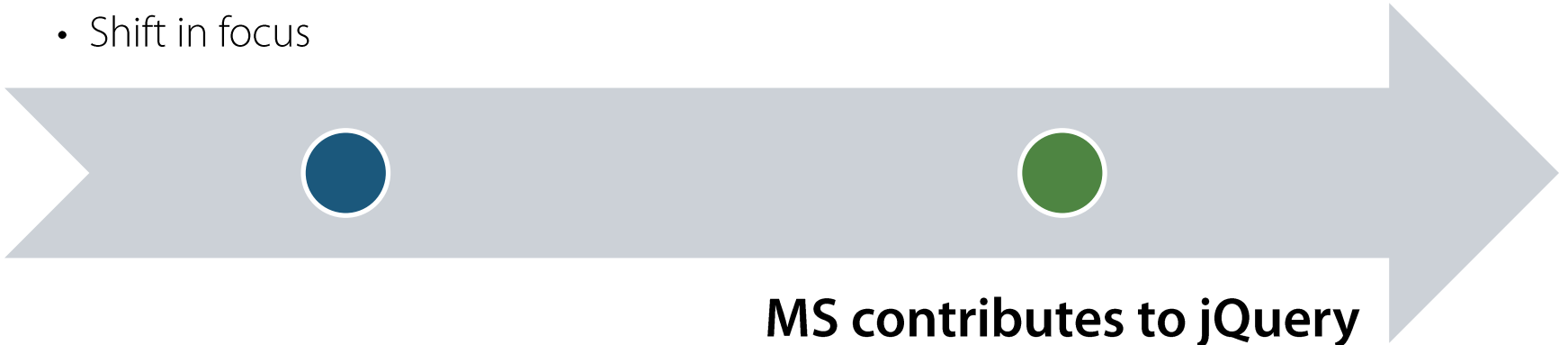

# jQuery templates

jQuery  
plugin

Client –

## Features

- Single object or arrays
- Conditionals
- Local or remote data

# Available template tags

`${}` – an expression or field

`{{if}}` and `{{else}}` – conditional output

`{{each}}` – iterate over array elements

`{{tmpl}}` – invoke another template

`{{html}}` – use literal (aka unencoded) HTML data

`{{wrap}}` – wrap another template which includes HTML

# data-link

## Binding one object to another

- Uses change events to update targets

## Currently “a little rough” in some aspects

- Support for control types

## jsRender + jsViews

- Update to templates and linking

## jQuery Datagrid

- Updates to some core plug-ins / APIs (including templates and binding)
